As you may all know by now our FEI WJC has been postponed due to insufficient entries.

Note that it is very important that the TTEA host this competition for 3 reasons:

1. We are going to be asking the FEI Solidarity for a lot of money for our development.

If we do not have this competition (or have it with very few entries) it does not auger well that the FEI will give us what we ask.

2. The competition is too expensive to run without as many riders as possible.

3. The TTEA needs money and must do a fund raising competition. Again, the Ministry of Sport expects us to help ourselves before they help us.

We can do this competition on any weekend between now the middle of August.

I know that this is holiday time and many of you have travel plans. So please let me know which weekends you are here between now and mid-August. The TTEA will choose the dates when we have the most riders.

If this is not working out, we will have to use SL3 for the FEI WJC. Everyone will ride at the 1.00m height over the FEI WJC courses and will receive points towards their SL level.

Should anyone have another idea to solve this problem, please let either Douglas Watson or Patrice Stollmeyer know and we will be very happy to look at it.

I ask you all to put your best foot forward and compromise for the good of our sport.
