The Trinidad & Tobago Equestrian Association hosted their Super League Show Jumping Competition on Sunday 19th October at Saddle Valley Stables, Upper Santa Cruz.


The High League class, maximum height 1.20m, went first with Mariel Lanser on Miramis riding the biggest course of her competitive career. Mariel had a credible round of only 12 faults. This was not good enough to go into the "jump off" but the rules allow riders to attempt the course again going "hors concours" (without competing). Mariel and Miramis improved considerably, having only one jump down for 4 faults in their second round. Mariel leads in the points for the High league with 220 points from Amber Thompson who is now riding abroad in with the Millerbrooke Farm in Canada, where she trains with Olympian show jumper, Ian Miller.

The Mid League class followed, with Brynn English on Nobill LX winning over the two rounds with a combined score of 4 faults. Hadley Rahael was second on the grey Viking Thunder with 12 faults and Adelle Stollmeyer on Audacity to Hope placing third with 17 faults. Rahael is leading in the standings in the Mid League with 300 points, from English with 220 points, Stollmeyer with 110 points and Sandhya Moll with 100 points.

Jordanne Brown on Mr. Wings was the winner in the Low League with a clear round from Sydney Navarro on Morocco who incurred 1 time fault. The second round in the Low League was cancelled due to inclement weather so the results of the first round stood as the final score. Navarro leads Brown in the standings with 320 points from 210.

Riders get double points when they ride in the Super League Finals so the rider of the year status in each category is still quite open. The Super League Final will be held on Sunday November 16th, at Saddle Valley Stables.
