The 2015 Super League consists of the following events:

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Master League: FEI World Jumping Challenge Category A (1.20m - 1.30m)
Super League: FEI World Jumping Challenge Category B (1.10m - 1.20m)
High League: FEI World Jumping Challenge Category C (1.00m - 1.10m)
Mid League (0.90m - 1.00m)
Low League (0.80m - 0.90m)
Mini League (Cross-rails w/max. 0.80m)
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Rules for the FEI World Jumping Challenge can be found at http://fei.org/system/files/Rules WCHA-S 2015 with Clarifications.pdf and all riders, coaches and officials are advised to familiarise themselves with these rules.

Please note all **FEI Athletes** must dress in accordance with the FEI Jumping rules, Art. 256. Super League Athletes dress code: light coloured breeches, any colour collared shirt with short or long sleeves. Helmets are required at all times while mounted.

Rule Clarifications for Mid League, Low League and Mini League

- The rules will follow the framework of the FEI World Jumping Challenge with modified FEI WJC courses to suit each level at the discretion of the OC.
- The Super League Points System is as follows:

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1<sup>st</sup> Place - 100 points
2<sup>nd</sup> Place - 90 points
3<sup>rd</sup> Place - 80 points
4<sup>th</sup> Place - 70 points
5<sup>th</sup> Place - 60 points
6<sup>th</sup> Place - 50 points
7<sup>th</sup> Place - 40 points
8<sup>th</sup> Place - 30 points
9<sup>th</sup> Place - 20 points
10<sup>th</sup> Place or lower - 10 points
*Participation - 10 points
*Any Athlete that begins the first round of declared entry.
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Points will be awarded to Riders only (not Rider/Horse combinations) for the Mid, Low and Mini League.

This year, we will introduce a Cross-Over League where Riders will be encouraged to move to a higher level if they choose and still earn points.

For example, Rider A may move from Low League to Mid League and Rider B may move from Mid League to High League and they will earn points based on their placing in the class they have entered. At the end of the year, all points will be added to determine the winner between Rider A and Rider B in the Cross-Over League.

- Riders may ride at a lower level (once organised and part of the Schedule) than in which they started at the <u>end</u> of the competition in the second round if they are eliminated in both rounds of their declared level, e.g. Mid League Rider may drop to Low League or Mini League. No points will be awarded.
- The third and final event of the Super League will carry double placing points. **TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR DOUBLE POINTS AT THE FINAL EVENT, RIDERS MUST HAVE COMPETED IN AT LEAST ONE COMPETITION PRIOR TO THE FINAL.**
