



Dressage Dress & Saddlery Code

Dressage Shirt & Collars

Show shirt in a conservative colour, with a stock-tie & pin or integrated standup collar. A polo shirt in a conservative colour is allowed for Introductory Levels.

Integrated Standup Collars

Show Jacket (Optional)

Short jacket in conservative colours. Bright piping allowed.



Short Show Jacket

Whips up to 120cm (100cm for ponies)
Allowed for USDF tests. Forbidden for FEI tests.

Helmet with Three-Point Retention Harness
Must be worn at all times while mounted

Manes
For CEA & FEI competitions, manes must be braided. Forelocks should be braided or neatly covered by a neutral toned fly bonnet.

White or Light-coloured Breeches
White or beige/fawn coloured breeches, with conservative coloured belt.

Saddle & Saddle Pad
All purpose saddles are allowed from First Level and below. Saddle Pads must be white.

Boots with a heel
Tall boots are required above First Level. Paddock boots with matching Half-Chaps are allowed from First Level and below.

Horses' Boots
No boots, polo wraps or bell boots are permitted in the competition arena.

Spurs
Mandatory for FEI tests. Optional for all other tests. Check booklet for permitted types.
